

Extract from email: 14 June 2005, Trevor Stay from Anglo Coal

- The current maximum capacity of the Anglo-Mitsui pipeline is 44TJ/day. Spare capacity does exist and it is available for use by third parties.
- The technical spare capacity of the Anglo-Mitsui pipeline is 23TJ/day (based on expected transportation in 2006). Preliminary discussions are being held with potential customers for amounts approaching an additional 21TJ/day. If all those discussions are successful, the Anglo-Mitsui pipeline on its present configuration may only have 2TJ/day spare capacity after 2007.
- [Confidential] currently has third party access to the Anglo-Mitsui pipeline.
- The Anglo-Mitsui pipeline is physically connected to other pipelines and so does provide an opportunity to transport gas to a broader gas sales market.
