National Gas Law

Application for revocation of coverage

The Council has received an application under section 102 of the National Gas Law from Envestra Limited for revocation of coverage of the Wagga Wagga natural gas distribution network. Should the relevant Minister, on receiving the Council's recommendation, decide to revoke coverage of the network, the natural gas distribution network in Wagga Wagga will no longer be covered and therefore will no longer be regulated under the National Gas Law.

In accordance with the standard consultative procedure in the National Gas Rules, the Council invites submissions on Envestra's application to be made by **5.00pm on Tuesday 28 May 2013**.

After considering submissions on the application, the Council will release a draft recommendation and invite further submissions before making its final recommendation to the relevant Minister.
